



Deep-Dive Compensation Study Overview

AirComp RX is the consulting arm of the AirComp Calculator and uses AirComp Calculator data to perform deep-dive compensation studies tailored to client specifications. The studies come in two formats, compensation range presentations and compensation analyses.

Compensation Range Presentations

Using its proprietary methodology, AirComp RX will provide compensation ranges for the job titles provided by the client.

- Services will include:
 - o Full description of methodology including the use of applicable surveys;
 - o Compensation ranges for base salary, total cash compensation, and total direct compensation (if applicable) at the 10th, 25th, 50th, 75th, and 90th percentiles for the job titles specified.
 - o Distribution analysis of total cash compensation for all positions;
 - o Target STI percentages for all positions;
 - o Generic airline career mapping for pilots vs. four major airlines; and
 - o Description of the current compensation environment.
- Deliverables will include:
 - A PowerPoint slide deck provided to Client suitable for presentation to executive personnel along with a Zoom or MS Teams call to deliver and explain the slides;
 - o An Excel workbook with compensation ranges for each job included (if desired).

Compensation Analyses

Using its proprietary methodology, AirComp RX will provide in-depth compensation analysis for the job titles and personnel compensation levels provided by the client.

- Compensation Analysis will include:
 - o Full description of methodology including the use of applicable surveys;
 - o In-depth compensation comparison and analysis of base salary, total cash compensation (with and without 401K match), and total direct compensation (if applicable) at the 10th, 25th, 50th, 75th, and 90th percentiles for the job titles specified and associated personnel compensation levels.
 - o Distribution analysis for total cash compensation for all personnel;

- o Target STI percentage comparison for all personnel;
- o Airline career mapping for pilots vs. the three top-paying major airlines;
- Description of the current compensation environment;
- Assessment of employee flight risk; and
- o Precise compensation recommendations tailored to the client's specifications.
- Final deliverable will consist of a PowerPoint slide deck provided to Client suitable for
 presentation to executive personnel along with a Zoom or MS Teams call to deliver
 and explain the slides.

AirComp Calculator Access

For both Compensation Range Presentations and Compensation Analyses, access to the AirComp Calculator will be provided for one year after the study with a number of reports equal to the number of job titles or personnel covered in the applicable study.

Process for the Study

After AirComp RX and the client agree on a service level and associated price, the following events will occur:

- 1) AirComp RX will generate a Statement of Work for the client to execute via DocuSign;
- 2) AirComp RX will provide an invoice for payment via QuickBooks;
 - a) If the price of the study exceeds \$3,000, 50% of the price will be billed at the start of the study and 50% will be billed when the final study is presented to the client;
 - b) If the price of the study is \$3,000 or less, the entire cost of the study will be billed up front;
- 3) For Compensational Analyses, AirComp RX will provide a data sheet for the client to complete with the applicable compensation data;
- 4) Once items 1-3 have been completed, AirComp RX will begin work; the typical time required to generate a study is approximately two weeks;
- 5) AirComp RX emails the study to client for client review and comment;
- 6) AirComp RX will make amendments or changes to the study per client direction, if required;
- 7) AirComp RX will email a final version of the study to client along with an invoice for the final payment, if applicable.
- 8) Dr. Christopher Broyhill will present the study to the company personnel desired by the client.
